

# COMMIT

COMMIT is a secure web-based case management system offered by MegaNexus Ltd. It allows for the ready collection of the CORC and CYP IAPT dataset elements. The system is designed with user experience and ease of use in mind.

## SECURE DATA


COMMIT provides secure patient data storage, linkage and analysis. It supports online delivery of therapy and training materials by enabling clinicians to enter in all relevant data about a child, including demographic as well as outcome information.

## DATA COLLECTION

Data entered into COMMIT is accepted and saved only in the approved response format and mandatory information is indicated where necessary.

## EFFORTLESS DATA EXPORTS

COMMIT users do not have to perform manual exports and uploads of data. Once authorised by the appropriate professional, quarterly and annual data is pulled from COMMIT to be reported to CORC.

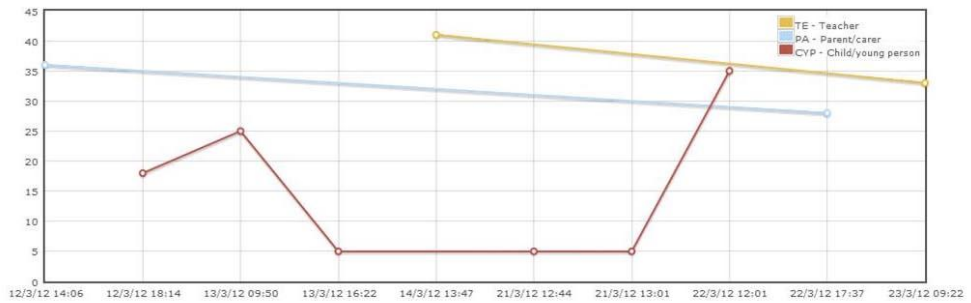

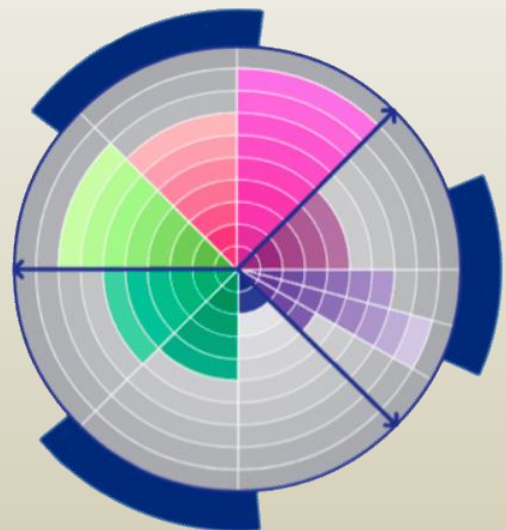

## CYP IAPT MEASURES

There are currently 25 clinical tools used for the CYP IAPT Project at the different stages of assessment and treatment. COMMIT can record and report the responses to all measures and will differentiate between multiple respondents and when the measures were completed.



## GRAPHICAL AND VISUAL TOOLS

COMMIT enables clinicians with the ability to easily view and print each patient's outcome information in graphical form. Distinctions between child and parent responses are colour-coded for analytical clarity.

## ENHANCE DIALOGUE

The charts and reports generated by COMMIT can enhance clinical work, facilitates communication between the practitioner and patient and encourages personal reflection.

## **DYNAMIC REPORTING TOOL**

COMMIT offers a custom reporting tool where specified information can be downloaded in a various formats. Reports can be generated for a wide variety of purposes, as broad as an organisational analysis to specific patient questionnaire responses. Detailed reports are up-to-date with relevant data and can be easily shared with people who need them. As a result, work is more efficient and accurate.



## **SYSTEM USE SUPPORT**

The COMMIT team provides on-site introductory system training and ongoing email and telephone support to ensure designated users understand exactly how to use it for their project needs.

## **BESPOKE SYSTEM**

MegaNexus can work with individual Services to develop more refined systems that are designed to aid shared decision making and enable clinical clustering across all Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services.

## **FREE ACCESS FOR CORC AND CYP IAPT MEMBERS**

Access to the COMMIT System is free of charge for CORC members until April 2015 and for CYP IAPT members until March 2013.
