DATA SUBMISSION FOR THE PBR PILOT

All service and data leads should now have received a copy of the briefing note to accompany the CYP IAPT version 2 data specification. The briefing note lists all the essential data items required to be collected and submitted for the PbR project. The CYP IAPT dataset and the file output specification provide the required detail about each of these data items. The file output specification explains exactly how the data should be exported from services' patient records system.

All sites will need to be uploading data electronically by the April submission dates (1st-15th April 2013).
