## WELCOME TO NEW PILOT SITES

We welcome three new sites to the project this month who are City and Hackney's First Steps Team (Homerton University Hospital NHS Foundation Trust), North East London Foundation Trust, and Leicestershire Partnership NHS Trust. We are very pleased to have these services on board with the project, taking the total number of sites to 22.

## DATA COLLECTION COMMENCES

All sites that received training from us in using the Current View tool in either October or November 2012 are starting to collect the dataset required for the PbR project this month. A special well done to Birmingham Children's Hospital who report that they have submitted data in January! If any other services have been able to upload data in January please get in touch. All sites that were trained in December or are due to be trained in January will be commencing data collection at the start of February.

## DATA COLLECTION PLANNING FORMS

We have now received Data Collection Planning Forms from fourteen sites; a big thank you to all of you for returning this as requested. The information provided gives us a clear understanding of your progress, and allows us to help you as much as possible with any questions or issues you may be facing. Data leads from those sites

that joined the pilot in 2012 who haven't yet completed a form, please send us this information whether or not you are able to answer all questions. If we do not hear from you we will be in touch to request all information that is outstanding.

This form is not only useful for us, but can help you think about how to ensure data collection, monitoring and submission are happening smoothly, and identify any potential issues.
